Dear Parents and Players,

The Board of Directors of the South Euclid Girls Softball League would like to wish each of you a happy and healthy start to 2007. Your daughter(s) played on a S.E.G.S.L. team last summer. Please use the enclosed [registration-by-mail](#) form to enroll children (6 to 18 years old) in the softball league for 2008. Please register by mail before **March 1st, 2008. One form per girl per league please.**

Parents who choose not to register by mail or who are new to the league, may [register in person](#) on the following dates at South Euclid City Hall:

**Saturday, February 9<sup>th</sup> ...9:00am-11:00 am**

**Sunday, February 17<sup>th</sup> ...12:00pm-2:00pm**

**Wednesday, February 27<sup>th</sup> ...7:00pm-8:00pm**

**\*Late Registration Saturday, March 8<sup>th</sup>.... 9:00am-11:00am\***

Due to rising costs of maintaining our parks a \$10.00 non-resident fee per child and a \$5.00 each additional child (per family) fee will now apply for players who do not reside in South Euclid.

Signing up early will ensure a spot on a team for your child. We will limit the number of players on each team so please do not get shut out. [Late registrations \(postdated after March 1st\)](#) are limited to available space and will be charged a \$10.00 **mandatory** late fee.

Players 11 and over have the option of playing [Fast Pitch](#). The fee for the Fast Pitch players is higher because of the additional equipment needed. Players age 11-12 may play both Fast Pitch and Slow-Pitch if scheduling allows.

Players who are new to Senior Pigtail, Ponytail or Fast Pitch Leagues will be required to attend the [tryouts](#) to be drafted onto a team. The tryouts will take place on **Saturday, March 15<sup>th</sup>, place to be determined**. You will be given information about these tryouts when you register.

The S.E.G.S.L. would like to offer players ages 15 and up the opportunity to umpire within the league. The league will offer an umpiring class, attendance will be mandatory. The date of the class is still to be determined. Call Tom Algeri 216-381-9773 for further details.

The S.E.G.S.L. will again conclude the season with a [banquet](#) for *each* league's percentage, playoff champion teams, outgoing seniors and their parents (except the Pixie League, which will have its own end-of-the-season party.). Players will receive their awards at this event, which will take place in late August or early September. Last year's banquet was well attended and a huge success.

The S.E.G.S.L. will hold its annual public meeting October 1<sup>st</sup>, 7:00pm SE City Hall. Residents are encouraged to attend. Your comments and questions will be answered at this time.

To continue to provide a competitive and instructive environment for your child, we need [parental involvement](#). Please get involved with your child and her team as a manager, coach or sponsor. The S.E.G.S.L. is always looking for eager volunteers.

Clinics again will be available for 9-14 year olds. The cost for the clinics is: \$10.00 for one session and \$15.00 for both.
